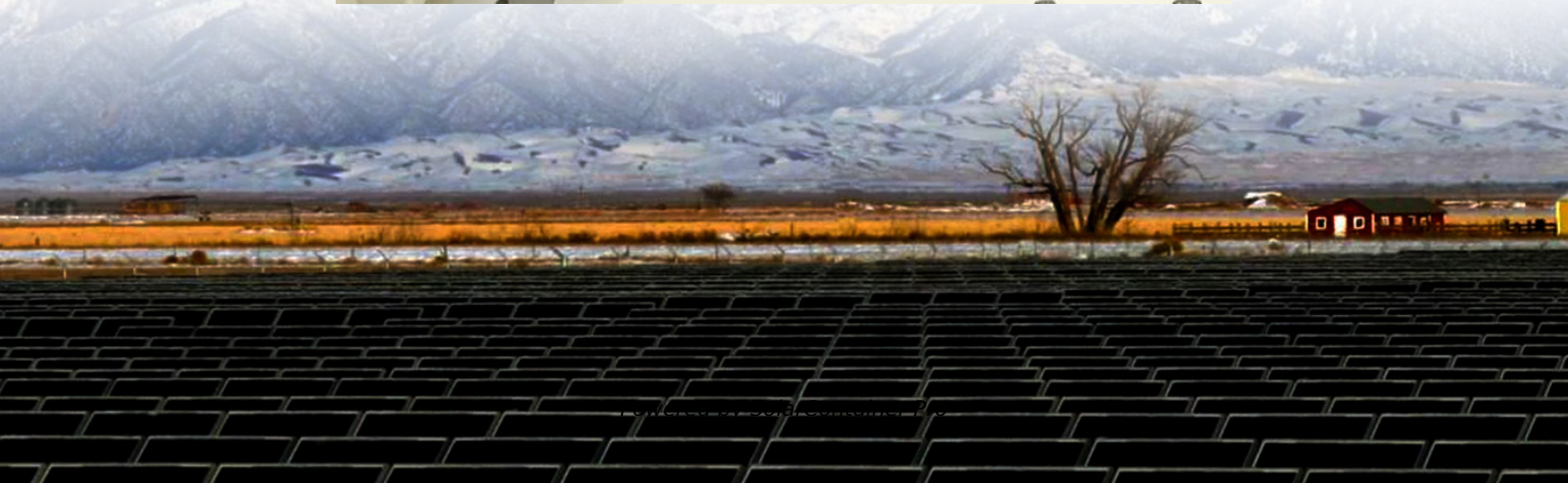

The Grand Inga Dam (French: Barrage du Grand Inga) is a series of seven proposed hydroelectric power stations at the site of the Inga Falls, in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. If built as planned, the 40–70 GW project would be the largest power station in the world.

The project would be located across the , approximately 150 kilometres (93 mi), upstream of where the river empties into the . This.

The project would involve building a dam across the south of the valley where it meets the Congo, then diverting the Congo from above the waterfalls into the north of the.
