Does Greece have a smart electricity grid?

Development of a smart electricity grid. Despite the advancement, the delignitization in the Greek power sector still has a considerable distance to cover. Carbon taxation has not yet been adopted in Greece as a means of curbing greenhouse gas emissions. Progress in infrastructure for vehicle electrification remains modest.

How many power plants does Greece have?

It owns and operates 34 major thermal and hydroelectric power plants and 3 aeolic parks of the interconnected power grid of the mainland, as well as 60 autonomous power plants located on Crete, Rhodes and other Greek islands (33 thermal, 2 hydroelectric, 18 aeolic and 5 photovoltaic parks).

Does Greece import or export electricity?

Greece participates in the EU's internal Electricity Market, allowing for electricity trade with other EU countries. Greece usually imports electricity during the summer months when demand is high and domestic production can fall short, and exports during low-demand periods, typically in winter.

What is the biggest emitter of energy in Greece?



The largest emitter of the energy sector is fuel combustion in electricity and heat production due to the usage of fossil fuels. Electricity fuel combustion in Greece dropped by 60% during the decade 2011-2021, due to the limitation of lignite use and the parallel increase of natural gas and RES.


