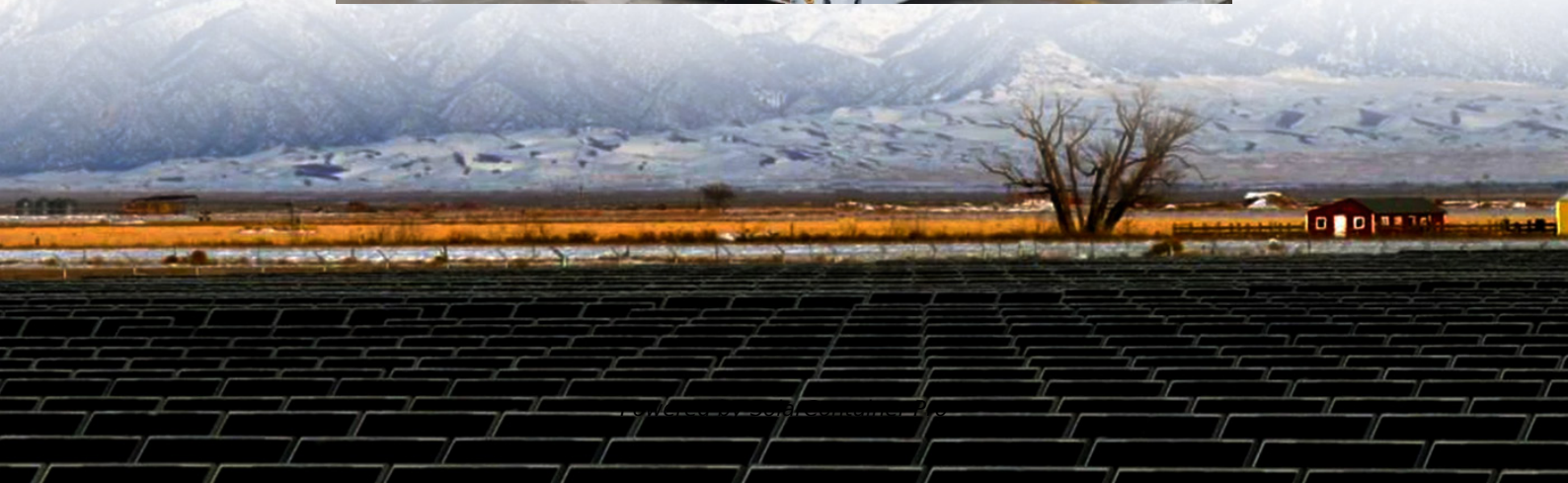


How much is the tariff for outdoor power supply in Zimbabwe





Overview

What are the ZESA electricity tariffs?

The document outlines the latest ZESA electricity tariffs effective from November 2, 2023, detailing a stepped tariff system where the cost per unit increases with higher consumption. It provides specific pricing for different consumption bands, including the estimated prices in USD and notes on the inclusion of a 6% Rural Electrification Levy.

What are ZETDC tariffs?

These are the latest ZERA-approved tariffs for the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC), the division of ZESA that provides electricity to homes and other final consumers. Some of the tariffs given by ZESA do not include a 6% Rural Electrification Levy.

Do prepaid meters & electricity tokens work in Zimbabwe?

In many parts of the world, including Zimbabwe, prepaid meters and buying electricity tokens have become a routine part of life. However, a common frustration that consumers often face is the uncertainty surrounding the exact units of electricity one will receive after purchasing your ZESA token.

Does your residential location affect ZESA tariffs?

Unlike the most popular opinion, your residential location has no effect on the current ZESA tariffs. Whether you stay in the high-density, low, or medium-density, ZESA tariffs remain the same. The price per unit is affected by your usage and whether or not it's your first purchase of that particular month.

How does ZETDC determine ZESA tariffs?

Here are some of the things ZETDC considers in determining the current ZESA tariffs, REA. The Rural Electrification Levy is collected by ZETDC on behalf of REA, an organization in Zimbabwe that focuses on bringing power to the rural parts of Zimbabwe. The REA Levy is 6% and is included in the ZESA tariffs for



your prepaid electricity token.

How much does ZWL cost per unit?

\$350 400.00 ZWL (US\$54.24) will be charged at the expensive tariff of \$45.51 ZWL per unit. If you spend less it means you are not taking advantage of the preferential tariffs available to you. Is electricity cheaper on the first day of the month?

The answer is yes and no.

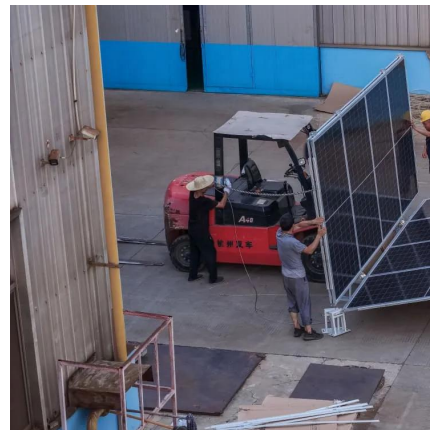

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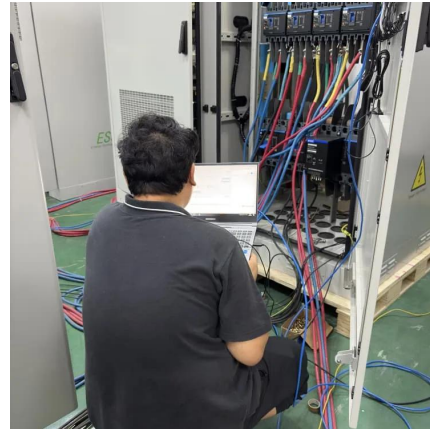
