

Malaysia photovoltaic module exports







Overview

In the same year, the major export destinations for Malaysia's PV products included the United States, which received 22.9% of the exports. Other key markets were Singapore and Hong Kong, each with 13.1%, followed by China at 11%, Germany at 9.9%, and Vietnam at 7.3%.

These companies are instrumental in advancing solar energy adoption in the country and supplying solar panels for both residential and commercial projects.

Could Malaysia's New photovoltaic export move finish the job?

"This latest move could finish the job." Malaysia exported RM37.4 billion worth of photovoltaic (PV) products in 2024, with the United States accounting for RM12.5 billion, or 33.4%, of that total, according to the Malaysia External Trade Development Corporation (Matrade).

Does Malaysia have a PV industry?

Having said that, despite US tariffs being imposed on Malaysia from 2018 to 2022, the Malaysian PV industry, along with that of its three Asean peers, has managed to grow, owing to the strong demand for the product. Almost all of



the PV products manufactured in Malaysia — largely PV cells and modules (cells that have been assembled) — are exported.

Are alternative solar financing options available in Malaysia?

Alternative forms of solar financing, such as solar PPAs and third-party solar leases, are now available in Malaysia as a result of the introduction of the new NEM scheme and the government's intention of "democratizing the market," Jack pointed out.

What are the challenges facing the photovoltaic market in Malaysia?

The photovoltaic market in Malaysia faces various challenges. One of the primary concerns is the dependency on government policies and incentives, which can change over time and impact the industry`s growth.

Which country produces the most photovoltaic modules in the world?

This ranking placed Malaysia behind both China, which dominated the market with a significant 77.8% share, and Vietnam, which accounted for 6.4% of the world's photovoltaic production. In 2014, Malaysia was the world's third largest manufacturer of PV modules behind China and the European Union.


