The cost to install an outdoor outlet is \$180 to \$350 on average, depending on the location, the home's wiring conditions, and whether the outlet requires adding a new circuit. How much does an outdoor outlet cover cost?

The installation estimate for an outdoor outlet typically includes a watertight or weatherproof enclosure. Outdoor outlets directly exposed to the elements must have a watertight cover labeled "Extra-Duty".

How long does it take to install an outdoor outlet?

Installing an outdoor outlet takes 1 to 4 hours on average, depending on if the electrician can tap in interior outlet on the opposite wall or instead must run new conduit inside the walls or along the home's exterior to connect the new outlet box to the main electrical panel.
