What Power Plugs and Outlets Are Used in Barbados?

In Barbados, there are two types of power plugs and outlets: Type A and Type B. Both types are used in airports, hotels, restaurants, etc., but they differ in terms of shape. Type A: Type A plugs have two flat prongs on either side of the plug.

What voltage is used in Barbados?

In Barbados, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A and type B are used. The standard voltage is 115 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Barbados is a beautiful Caribbean island nation known for its pristine beaches, crystal-clear waters, and vibrant culture.

Do device plugs work in Barbados?

Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Barbados. Also, the voltage in Barbados is the same as in North America. Please note: an adapter will be needed if your device plug has a grounding pin and you are trying to use a Type A outlet. For this reason, we always recommend traveling with a universal travel adapter.

What type of outlets are in Barbados?

The majority of outlets in Barbados are type A, but some outlets may be type B. The standard voltage in Barbados is 115 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. If you are traveling to Barbados with a device that uses a different plug type or voltage, you will need to bring a travel adapter.

Do I need a travel adapter in Barbados?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Barbados are of types A & B (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you



don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

Are electronic devices compatible with a 115v outlet in Barbados?

Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. Barbados uses outlet types A, B at a voltage of 115V and a frequency of 50 Hz.
